The Social Care Induction Programme is a comprehensive course for people choosing a career in Social Care. It covers all 'day one' and 'week one' priorities identified in the Care Council for Wales Induction Framework.

The Programme covers all the necessary elements of induction training and gives individuals the underpinning knowledge and practical experiences they need to become confident care professionals. It also provides attendees with evidence that they can submit towards their level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care.

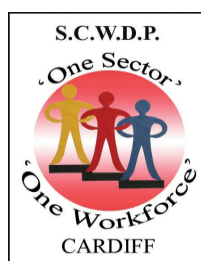

City and Guilds Level 2 Award in Social Care Induction.

Social Care Induction Taught Programme (SCIP)

Cardiff County Council are working in partnership with Cardiff and Vale College to deliver a bespoke course designed to provide workers, who are new to the care sector, with a 'standardised' or 'common' understanding of care practice and legislation.

The SCIP aims to meet the knowledge elements of the learning objectives identified within the Care Council for Wales 'Social Care Induction Framework', whilst embedding the Social Services and Well Being Act 2014. (The trainer is a Care Council registered trainer for the Act and she updates information prior to each programme).

We offer the SCIP 5 - 6 times a year for cohorts of up to 24 learners. Each programme runs for 6 days and is open to **All** care professionals or potential care professionals in the Cardiff and Vale area.

Each attendee is provided with a portfolio which contains a progress log for them to take into their workplace, where managers and mentors can confirm competency. The portfolio also contains a link to Workbooks that cover the 'Knowledge' criteria within the level 2 HSC Diploma.

The Council has requested that we offer an accredited qualification for the taught programme to learners who want to continue along a career path within Health and Social Care. We have therefore ensured that the taught programme is mapped to both the Level 2 Award in Social Care Induction (Wales) and the Health and Social Care Level 2 Diploma.

Attendees who attend the first 4 days of the taught programme will be offered the opportunity to undertake the City & Guilds Level 2 Award in Social Care Induction (Wales).

What this will involve;

- The learner will need to complete 6 units (7credits)
- Each of the units has an assignment
- Learners will be given an appointment time, to attend the College, approx. 2 weeks after programme completion to meet with their tutor, discuss, plan and submit any completed assignments for assessment.
- They will then be given another appointment to attend College to submit their completed portfolio and receive feedback.

The duration of the award should take 6 weeks from the end date of the Social Care Induction Programme.

Learners are encouraged to use their portfolio as a working tool, which they update regularly with workplace policies and legislative changes once they are employed. They are also encouraged to undertake the QCF Diploma once they have completed the full induction framework.
